COVID-19 COMPETITION PROTOCOL

Please make sure all of your teams and spectators attending know that these rules will be enforced.

- There will be smaller sessions to allow for Social Distancing during the meet.
- **Spectators will be limited to 4 per gymnast which is less than 30% of our seating capacity.**
- Teams will be kept separate at each event to allow Social Distancing between competitors.
- Separate entrances and exits will be clearly marked, as to prevent cross contamination.
- Out of town teams will be scheduled on the same day, **if at all possible**, so overnight hotels will not be necessary.
- If the event is cancelled or if an individuals or team provide a doctor's note with a Covid diagnosis after the refund deadline, they may be partially refunded after our expenses incurred are deducted.
- All spectators are charged the same \$10 entry fee - no distinguishing between adult and child
- Temperature check and mask on is required to enter building
- Masks must be worn at all times inside the building by all spectators, officials, coaches and volunteers
- Gymnasts must wear masks at all times including general stretch, rotating and seating; but may remove mask only for the event warm-ups and actual time they are competing.
- Coaches will have store or restaurant purchased boxed food and professionally store bought packed snacks- Coaches room will have a strict maximum occupancy posted and designated chairs and eating areas to incorporate social distancing
- Gymnasts hands will be sanitized between rotations
- Gymnast will be recognized and presented awards for the spectators at their last event- Coaches of the gymnasts will be given the medals to hand to their own gymnasts.
- Judges will all have individual tables. Timers will be separated from the judges. Gymnasts or coaches will not be permitted to approach judges.
- Judges and coaches hospitality areas are separate and socially distanced
- Please note these procedures may change as the CDC and local guidelines are updated. Please check back for updates closer to the meet.
